### How to find out about your device On an iPad

- 1) open your iPad and tap on Setting / General
- 2) Note down your Model Name and Model Number
- 3) Go to the following web site: https://support.apple.com/en-us/108043
- 4) Scroll down to find your model
- 5) Click the link for Tech Specs for your matching device
- 6) Scroll down to Chip to see if you have an M1 or newer device (M2,M3,M4)
- 7) If you have an M Chip you are ready for Apple Intelligence

### How to Find out about your device **On an iPhone**

- 1) Tap on Settings
- 2) Tap on About
- 3) Look at the Model Name
- 4) You are ready for Apple Intelligence if your Model Name begins with iPhone 16 or iPhone 15 Pro

### How to Find out about your device On a Mac

- Click on the Apple icon in the top left of the menu bar 1)
- 2) Click About this Mac
- If the Processor line says "Intel" your device does not support Apple Intelligence 3) If the Processor Line says M1, M2, M3, or M4 you device is ready for AI 4)
